Description of Type Design Change:

Recognition light installation on horizontal stabilizer in accordance with DeVore Top Drawing 15000001, Rev. "A" dated February 15, 1977 or later FAA approved revisions.

Limitations and Conditions:

The approval of this change in type design applies to the Cessna Model 150 series plus the 152 and the A152 aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the interrelationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. This determination should include consideration of significant change in weight distribution such as an increase in the fixed disposable weight of the fuselage.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
